


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
1 Safety Warnings

1.1 2. 5m Floating Cable Instrutions

1.1.1 Confirm the Sealing Ring is assembled on the Joint before operating the Pool Cleaner as Pic.1.1.2.



1.1.2 Equip the Floating Cable to the Pool Cleaner as Pic.1.2.2



1.1.3 WARNING: Lift the Pool Cleaner out of the water by using the robot handles, do not lift the Pool Cleaner by using the Floating Cable. Lifting via the cable is forbidden and voids the warranty.

1.2 Floating Battery Instructions



1.2.1 It is designed to be used together with Pool Cleaner Series. Any other use is prohibited and will void manufacturers' warranty.



1.2.2 Do not swim in the pool whilst the Floating Battery is in use in order to avoid personal injury.



1.2.3 It is recommended to be placed in a shady, dry and ventilated area.



1.2.4 Do not use the Floating Battery if there is a chance of thunder storm to avoid personal injury.



1.2.5 Ensure the Pool Cleaner is fully submerged before turning Power Switch on.



1.2.6 If the Pool Cleaner is not going be used for a long time, make sure to disconnect the Floating Battery, keep it clean and put it in a safe, dry and well-ventilated area.



1.2.7 If the Pool Cleaner stops working, please refer to section 8 "Troubleshooting", If you cannot find the root cause, please contact your local distributor.



1.2.8 The optimum working temperature for the Pool Cleaner is between 10°C and 32°C, avoid direct sunlight when not in use.



1.2.9 The Floating Battery is suitable for the swimming pools no deeper than 2.5 meters.



1.2.10 Ensure the battery is charged in a shady, dry and well-ventilated area.



1.2.11 Full charge-discharge once per every three months to extend the battery life.



1.2.12 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.





4 Main Parts



- Start the System by pressing the Power Switch shortly;
 Press the Power Switch for 3 seconds to shut off the power in Emergency.





5 Display Lights



- 1. When the Battery is fully charged, the four Power Display Lights are on. Otherwise, it is non-fully charged.
- 2. When using the Remote Control to set the cycle time, the corresponding Display Light flashes.

6 Battery Recharges




When the battery power is low, the battery needs to be charged:

- 5.1 Please use the Charger to connect the battery and outside AC power to charge.
- 5.2 Charging Time: approximately 6 hours.

Note: When the Charging Indicator turns green, the battery is fully charged.


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7 Installation



- 1. Use the 2.5m Floating Cable to connect the Main Body and the Floating Battery;
- $2 \times$ Put the Main Body into the water firstly, then press the Power Switch $\,$ and put the Floating Battery into the water.

8 Troubleshooting and Warning Lights

| Display Light | Failure | Solution |
|---|--|--|
| Number 1 light flashing | The Pool Cleaner stops due to lacking of water | Return the Pool Cleaner to deeper water and restart |
| Number 2 light flashing | The Motor Pump inside the Pool Cleaner has over heated | Contact the supplier for support |
| Number 3 light flashing | The Pool Cleaner is upside down | Turn the Pool Cleaner over, and restart using the Remote Control or Power Switch |
| Number 1 and 3 lights flashing | The Walking (Drive Wheel) Motors are over loaded | Check the Walking Motors, Drive Tracks and Tracking Belts for debris or damage. Clear bebris or replace parts and restart the Pool Cleaner. |
| Number 1 \ 2 and 3 lights flashing | The Weater Pump is over loaded | 1. Turn the robot off, check the Impeller for debris, or damage.2. Clear or replace Impeller, then restart the Pool Cleaner. |
| | The Floating Battery is low | Battery needs to be recharged. |
| Number 1, 2, 3 and 4 lights flasing | The Selected cycle has finished The robot shuts off by Remote Control | Shut off the robot by the Power Switch. |
